EXAMINATIONS OF CONSCIENCE

(Invite the group to pause to reflect on how each has responded to God's call to love, share and serve throughout this day. At the end, the prayer format below can be shared aloud or another prayer can be prayed.)

Guide: Let us ask Mary, our Mother and Help of Christians, to help us walk in the footsteps of her Son Jesus, as we sing:
